UWM begins research of the state of organizational culture. This is one of the elements of the development strategy for 2021-2030 adopted by the UWM Senate. The action is focused on improving human, financial and technical resource management. It will be accompanied by a series of workshops, including an inspiration workshop, an analysis and a workshop on development directions or brand strategy. In the second stage, project groups will develop solutions for the transformation of the organizational culture. The last stage will consist of implementing the developed changes.
